Supervisor Ziegler stated the public hearing on proposed changes to Article VIII of the Industrial Zoning Regulations remains open since May 13 and it will continue this evening on June 10, 2014 beginning at 7:41 p.m.

The Town Clerk read the Saratoga County Planning Board Referral Review #14-93 Town of Ballston Zoning Amendments, Local Law #1 of 2014: Deletion of Light and Heavy Manufacturing as defined uses and replacement with defined uses of Light and Heavy Industrial; amendments to add several permitted uses under Light Industrial; and create a list of explicitly prohibited uses. Various defined parcels along Charlton Road (CR #51), NYS Routes 67 & and NYS Route 50.
