

A public hearing was held by the Town Board of the Town of Ballston on Tuesday evening, November 25, 2014 at the Town Hall on Charlton Road, Ballston Spa.

Supervisor Ziegler opened the public hearing at 7:50 p.m. He stated that this local law was recommended by Highway Superintendent Joseph Whalen to improve the quality of the roads in the Town of Ballston. Mr. Whalen worked with Town Engineer Katherine Serra to upgrade the road standards and at the same time to reorganize all the information on the sanitary sewers in one place in the Town Code.

Town Attorney Walsh said Highway Superintendent Joseph Whalen found that roads were deteriorating at a quicker pace that he felt was appropriate. Mr. Whalen had an increased concern at the length of time before the roads needed maintenance and these more stringent road standards will increase the longevity of the roads and decrease the cost of road maintenance.

Said specifications would pertain to the minimum specifications and standards necessary for road construction within the Town of Ballston. The Proposed Local Law No. 5 of 2014 and copies of the documentation submitted in support of the local law are available for public review in the Office of Town Clerk located at 323 Charlton Road, Ballston Spa, New York 12020. All persons are welcome to offer their oral and/or written comments at the above time and place.
