~Tim Zukas, Eagle Scout candidate, has received approval for constructing 4 baseball benches for the back ball field. He will complete his project in the next couple of weeks.

~Another discussion ensued deciding to get a quote from Brett Kucharski/NE Landscaping for one more day of excavating work around back ball field to help eradicate the poison ivy. Also, ask Brett to repair damaged area south side of pavilion (fill needed) and also distribute stone dust around trails' perimeter for the Eagle Scout project.

~ A follow-up discussion regarding hiring Kevin McCarty, for treating the ponds for algae and poison ivy treatments around the back ball field. It's too late this year, so we will re-address in spring 2016.

~Thank you to Bill Bechtel for his work on the JPAB 2016 Budget request proposal and submitting it to the Town Board.
