### **Streetlights**

Currently waiting on National Grid to give the town a quote for purchase of the cobra head streetlights. This continues to be a waiting game. Discussion if it might move forward if the town were to do an RFP.

### **Demand Response**

Jeff Varecka from National Grid with Demand Response programming reached out in response to a letter sent requesting more information on Smart Thermostats. Maegan has been in contact with him to gather information needed for the Community Campaign. Hope to have this ready for Black Friday.

Scoping documents for Demand Response and EV community Campaigns have been submitted to NYSERDA for approval. Approval is usually in 2-4 weeks.

### **Other**

Nathaniel Berry shared that National Grid has a program called VTO (voluntary time of use) that allows the private homeowner to schedule the time for charging their plug in electric vehicle for off peak hours, thereby reducing operating costs.
